It is my understanding that Mr. John Donovan is under consideration for a Professorship at the Palm Beach Medical College.

I am the Director of Environmental Services at LEC Environmental Consultants, Inc., an environmental consulting company in business since 1987. LEC specializes in wetlands, wildlife, and waterways, and associated permitting.


I have known Mr. Donovan since 1994. LEC has provided environmental consulting services for several parcels under his care, including a parcel of land known as the 'beach lot' on Smith's Point Road in Manchester-by-the-Sea, Massachusetts. During my involvement with this parcel, Mr. Donovan complied with all Orders from the Conservation Commission regarding site improvements (stone wall repair; drainage improvements; dune restoration; and landscape plantings).

Subsequent to completion of this work, Mr. Donovan also pursued permits for construction of a dock at the beach lot. Under existing conditions, three docks are located along the stretch of beach that includes the beach lot. During his permitting efforts, neighborhood opposition arose and eventually Mr. Donovan abandoned his efforts. To the best of my knowledge, no dock has been constructed on this lot.
